ANZAC Day Memorial Service

Students and staff are invited and encouraged to attend the ANZAC Day Memorial Service being held in Biggenden on Thursday, 25th April 2024. Students are requested to dress in full school uniform. Our senior students will carry our school banner during the march with our school captain laying a wreath during the service. It is requested that students arrive at the Biggenden CWA hall no later than 8.10am with the parade to commence at 8.30am. Students and staff will march from the CWA Hall to the Biggenden Memorial Hall where the ANZAC service will be held. The school will provide students with a wide brimmed hat and an ANZAC Day badge to wear.

Biggenden CWA Colouring In Competition

The QCWA Biggenden Branch are inviting students to enter entries in their International Children's Colouring in Competition as part of their Annual Competition Social Day. Competition entries has now been extended to 9th May, 2024. Please return entries to the school by Tuesday, 7th May.
