NAPLAN Year 3 & 5 Performance Indicators:

- Increase the percentage of Year 3 & 5 students meeting National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading to 100% in 2020.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 & 5 students meeting NMS in Writing to 100% in 2020.
- Increase the percentage of Year 3 & 5 students meeting NMS in Numeracy to 100% in 2020.
- Develop staff capacity, to improve student performance in reading, writing and numeracy through staff learning and development programs.
- Monitor PM Benchmarks and PROBE benchmarks
- Monitor movement on P-10 Literacy Continuum
- Monitor targeted intervention for students requiring additional support.

Our initiatives include

- Providing responsive targeted intervention for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement utilising the Case Management Approach.
- Implement collaborative data inquiry processes, to build staff ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices in reading, writing and numeracy.
- Develop staff capability by providing Professional Development in numeracy, reading and writing.
- Monitor student movement on the P-10 Literacy continuum, Early Start and PROBE reading assessments.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Building capacity in school staff to effectively plan and implement evidence-based programs and strategies which specifically target the development of literacy and numeracy through Professional Development.
- Investing in updating resources to support effective teaching and learning in literacy and numeracy.
- Engaging additional Teacher Aide to support identified students.
- Engaging additional teacher to assess EARLY START and PROBE reading assessments to monitor student development and develop specific learning goals.
- Engaging second teacher (increase fraction) for 25 students for quality education for all students.
